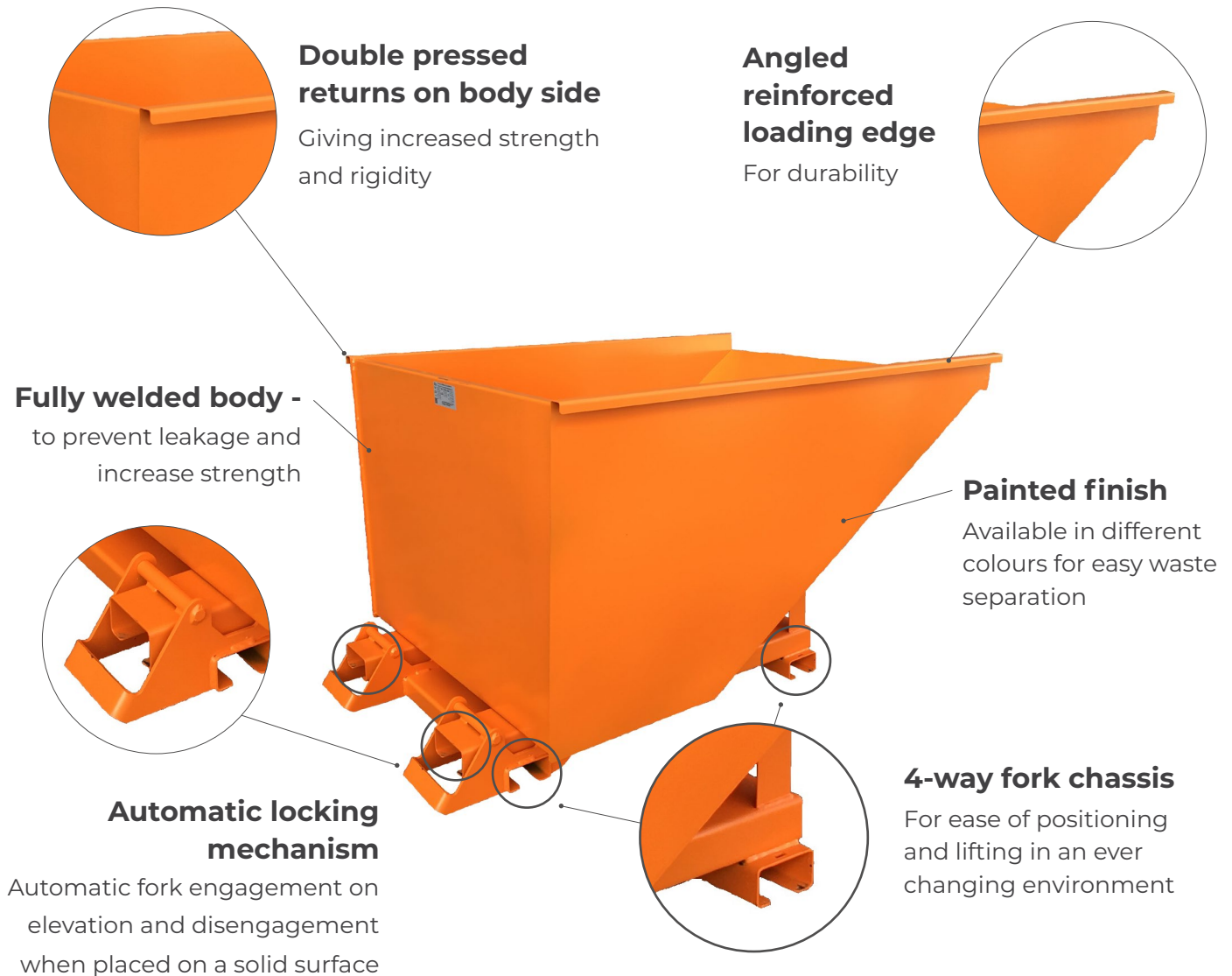

Simply drive your forks into the pockets and the automatic locking mechanism locks itself to the forks of the telehandler when elevated.

Stay safe and work with minimum hassle

There's no need for you to leave the safety of your cab during the lifting or emptying operation process.

Manufactured in the UK, the attachment's really easy to position, thanks to the 4-way pocket entry.



A STEP-BY-STEP GUIDE TO USING THE AUTO LOK TIPPING SKIP:

1. Position the forks the correct distance apart to locate into fork pockets.
2. Drive forks into the fork pockets until fully inserted.
3. Elevate the skip clear of the ground to fully engage the auto lock mechanism.
4. Take the forklift skip to the intended area to be emptied.
5. Using the telehandler controls, tilt the forklift forks forward until the contents of the skip start to discharge.
6. Once fully discharged, return the forklift forks back to a horizontal position.
7. Place the skip on to a solid surface to fully disengage the auto lock mechanism and retract the forklift forks.
8. The skip is now ready for use again.

THOROUGH EXAMINATION FOR THE AUTO LOK SKIP

Thorough Examinations (TE) are visible inspections to check the safety of your skips.

WHO IS RESPONSIBLE?

The user of the skip. Whether you have purchased the skip or have the attachment on hire, you must ensure that you have valid **Report of Thorough Examination**.

TEs are required by law and fall under the HSE Regulations of LOLER (Lifting Operations and Lifting Equipment Regulations 1998) and PUWER (Provision and Use of Work Equipment Regulations 1998).



How often does the examination need carrying out?

If the skip is in regular service and/or exposed to conditions causing deterioration, then every 6 months, or even, every 4 months in arduous environments.

With our trained Consolidated Fork Truck Services (CFTS) Inspector. We attend your site and carry out an inspection of your skip and leave you with the report. It includes any action to take and a next inspection date.
