

The fork-mounted Snow Plough clears freshly fallen or compacted snow in seconds. It allows safe access for vehicles and people to car parks, access roads and service yards. The plough has a fully galvanized finish and comes with an optional rubber blade insert.





The Adjustable Blade Snow Plough is suited to clearing snow on paths and roads with bends and curved borders. The plough clears freshly fallen or compacted snow with ease, allowing safe access for vehicles and people to car parks, access roads and service yards.



Often seen as a winter product, this snow plough is versatile, durable and has multiple uses. Primarily used to clear fresh fallen or compacted snow, they also offer a fantastic secondary use out of season for clearing yards and loose debris such as gravel.







Use your existing forklift and tug machine to salt your private access road and goods yards with the towable spreader. The spreader is attached with either a standard towing eye or ball hitch. It salts the area via the contact axle wheels and gearbox without any electrical or hydraulic connections..



A hydraulically driven salt spreader/gritter, with safe and convenient fork pockets for front mounting. It is driven from the forklift truck's third service valve or side shift valve. Fitted with stainless steel double auger system which can spread all types of salt, with a 0.20m³ hopper to take around 250kg of salt.
